Please note: There is a \$10 fee charged for cancellations within 72 hours of the trip. Non-residents pay a \$10 fee for going on Taylor Community trips.

The trips have descriptors – **Easy, Moderate, and Independent** – indicating the degree of mobility [walking, standing, stepping, etc.] required in order to safely participate and enjoy the trip. If a trip requires pre-paid tickets or entry fees, you cannot be reimbursed if you cancel from the trip OR if Taylor needs to cancel the trip due to weather conditions that make driving unsafe.

Friday – January 2 – Trip to the Currier Museum of Art [Easy to Moderate - a lot of optional walking in the museum] The museum is currently hosting a special exhibit by M.C. Escher: Reality and Illusion, intricate geometric drawings and prints of spaces that continue to boggle the mind and captivate viewers. In addition to the regular museum admission fee of &10.00, admission to this special exhibit is \$5.00 more. You will be paying at the ticket



office so please have the exact amount of money with you. After the tour we will dine in the Museum Cafe. There will be time to browse the museum gift shop before heading home. The bus will begin picking up residents on the Laconia campus at 9:45 AM and will make a convenience stop at the Concord Bus Station between 10:30 AM and 10:45 AM. Early Sign-Up: you may sign up now for this trip.



Friday – January 9 – Winter Mountain Tour with Lunch at Fabyan's Station in Crawford Notch [Easy] One of the original railroad stations restored and converted to a restaurant and lounge, Fabyan's is located across from Bretton Woods alpine area. The Fabyan's menu includes typical pub menu items, including delicious house-smoked choices as well as soups, salads and other entrees. After lunch we'll drive across Route 302 into North Conway as we head back to Laconia. The bus will begin picking up residents on the Laconia campus at 10:00 AM.

Friday – January 16 – Lunch Out at Red Blazer followed by Tour of the Bureau of Emergency Communications in Concord [Easy] The Red Blazer specializes in fresh seafood and hand-cut steaks. They also



offer a large selection of pub fare, soups, salads and sandwiches. The Division of Emergency Services oversees emergency communication in the State using the latest technology to provide NH residents and visitors with police, fire or emergency medical assistance. By calling 9-1-1 from any telephone in NH, help can be dispatched in minutes. Caller ID technology allows the center to get help to people even if they cannot speak. The 2:00 tour by Wanda Bowers will take you into the heart of the command center for 9-1-1 communications. The bus will begin picking up residents on the Laconia Campus at 10:45 AM and will make a convenience stop at the Concord Bus Station at between 11:30 AM and 11:45 AM.



Friday – January 23 – Lunch at the Greenside Restaurant in Tilton followed by a visit to the Belknap Mill Art Gallery [Easy] This restaurant stop will be a first for a Taylor Community trip. The Greenside boasts "Made to Order Specialties" at a reasonable price. Try a hand-cut steak, fresh seafood or a pasta dish. The Art Gallery features a continuous display of juried artwork, including oils, watercolors, ceramics and sculptures by area artists. There is also exhibition space for "Where Art Comes Alive" exhibits. You will have time to tour the mill

museum and gift shop. The bus will begin picking up residents on the Laconia campus at 11:00 AM.

Wednesday – January 28 – Dinner at the Local Eatery in downtown Laconia [Easy] Wednesday is half-price appetizer and beer night and the food is delicious. Chef Kevin Halligan offers a variety of entrées such as braised beef, pan-seared scallops, grilled lamb rack, fried chicken and biscuits, roasted pumpkin ravioli and more. You might want to top off your meal with the hot sugared donuts with your choice of maple syrup or vanilla creme anglaise. It is a dessert to be shared.
