Dear Taylor Community,

The news that LRGHealthcare filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy yesterday certainly caused alarm for some in our community. Today, I want to reassure you that this is actually a positive step forward for an organization that has been struggling for quite some time.

First, rest assured that the doors will remain open at our local healthcare facilities. It is our understanding that staffing and patient care will continue uninterrupted while the bankruptcy proceedings are handled in the courts. Second, the prospect of a well-respected and financially stable organization like Concord Hospital stepping in to provide a path forward for our local healthcare system's long-term financial stability is a very good thing. Finally, the State of New Hampshire has stepped in, assuring the community that it will provide any resources necessary to help continue services as LRGHealthcare navigates the bankruptcy process.

We will continue to closely monitor this situation and keep you informed of any developments as we learn them. Until then, please know that yesterday's news, while striking, is a step in the right direction for our local healthcare system.
